COURSE BASIC SAFETY TRAINING REFRESHER

TARGET GROUP

This course has been designed for personnel who hold “Basic Safety Training” certificate and need to update their proficiency.
Requirement: Have the Certificate of Basic Safety Training.

TRAINING

Objective: The course has been designed to update the practical skills set out in the Resolution dated 21 September of the General Directorate of the Merchant Marine.

Law: Updated Proficiency in “Basic Safety Training” according to the Resolution dated 21 September of the General Directorate of the Merchant Marine.

Ministry of Civil Works order of 4 September 2002.

Updated Proficiency in basic safety, regulated by:

Fire-fighting: Amended STCW/78 Convention: Rule VI/1; Section A-VI/1.3; Table A-VI/ 1-2 of the Code.

Survive at sea: Amended STCW/78 Convention: Rule VI/1; Section A-VI/1.3; Table A-VI/ 1-1 of the Code.

The Jovellanos Center is homologated by the DGMM Resolution of June 16, 2003.

DURATION

The course consists of 16 hours and it’s delivered over a period of 2 days.

PROGRAMME

Survive at Sea in the event of ship abandonment.
Fire prevention and fire fighting.

CERTIFICATE

Valid for 5 years.
